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Description



Located on a rocky spur and surrounded by green woods, among pines and oaks of rare beauty, stands the **Municipality of Bagnone**, a village well known for the cultivation of the Treschietto onion. The village is characterized by the waterfalls that flow on the right side of the village, formed in the rock by the flow of the **Bagnone stream** that gives its name to the village. The **circular tower** located in this area of the village was used to control the viability of the valley and was connected with the other similar towers: Malgrate, Groppoli and Mulazzo. Bagnone is famous for the cultivation of the **Treschietto onion**, small and round, pinkish in color and sweet flavor, produced between November and December. Its use in the kitchen is very wide, it is excellent both raw and cooked, the savory baked pies that contain it are particularly delicious. At the table, you should also try typical **dishes** such as **panigacci** and **testaroli**.

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How to reach Bagnone

By car	Easily accessible by car thanks to the proximity of the A15 Parma-La Spezia motorway (Autocamionale della Cisa). From the North (Parma, Milan, Bologna) • Take the A1 motorway towards Bologna. • At Parma Ovest, take the A15 motorway towards La Spezia. • Exit at Pontremoli and follow the signs for Filattiera, Villafranca, Bagnone. From the South (Florence, Pisa, La Spezia) • From Florence, take the A11 motorway to Lucca and then continue on the A12 towards La Spezia. • From Pisa or Livorno, follow the A12 motorway directly to La Spezia. • In La Spezia, take the A15 motorway towards Parma. • Exit at Aulla and follow the signs for Villafranca, Bagnone.
By plane	The preferred airport to reach Bagnone is: • Pisa Airport (Galileo Galilei Airport) 98 km away

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	From Pisa, you can take a rental car or taxi to reach Pontremoli via the A12 motorway and then the A15. Alternatively, you can take a train from Pisa Station to La Spezia and then a regional train to Aulla and a taxi or bus to Bagnone.

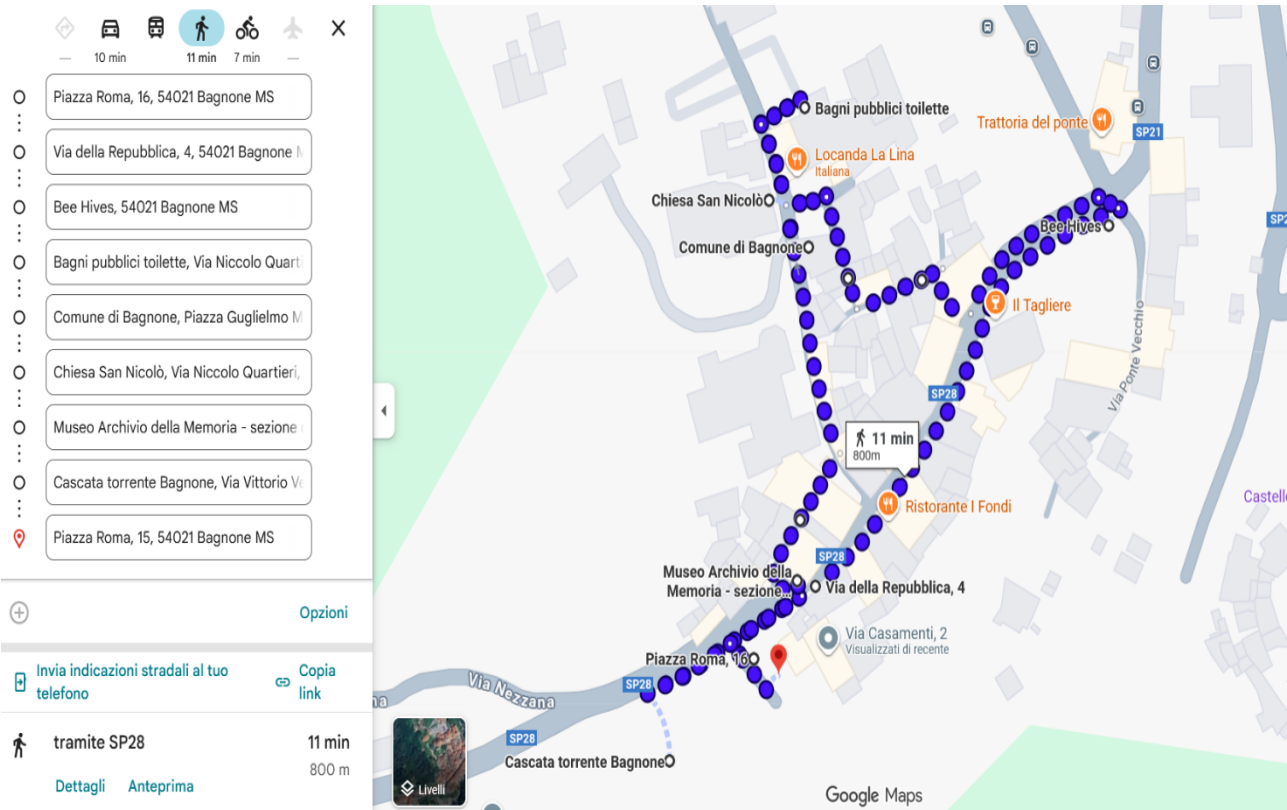
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Description of the itinerary

From Piazza Roma you have to cross the street to continue on Via della Repubblica and get to the pedestrian path under the portico being careful of the alternating direction of the cars.





Once in Piazza Europa, the Teatro Comunale Quartieri stands out at number 1. From here you cross the bridge again to take the arch on the right that leads to Via della Gora and then continue on Via Antonio Noceti to arrive in Piazza Guglielmo Marconi.

Adjacent to the square is the Town Hall. At number 7 the documentary part of the Archive Museum of Memory, which is now temporarily closed. Here there is also the Marconi Bar with an accessible entrance on the flat, but without toilets accessible to people with disabilities in wheelchairs, the La Lina Restaurant, accessible only externally during the summer due to the presence of stairs and the church of San Nicolò.

The church consecrated in 1731 The church, of new imposing dimensions, with a single nave, with a large central dome, a large choir, decorated with polychrome marble and neoclassical columns, was adorned with vestments and equipped with a pipe organ built by Ferrara artisans. Valuable is a statue of Our Lady of Sorrows made from a block of chestnut trees. From Piazza Marconi, continuing on the right on Via G.B. Cartegni, you reach the toilets accessible to the disabled, while on the left on Via Nicolò Quartieri you arrive in Via della Dogana. From here it is necessary to cross the road again to return to Piazza Roma, and through the ramp on the side reach the panoramic point on the waterfall of the Bagnone stream and the upper part of the town with the Castle and the cylindrical tower. From this beautiful panoramic point you can glimpse the Church of San Rocco built in the sixteenth century and where in ancient times there was a hospital dedicated to St. Anthony, and in 1619 it passed to the Augustinian Fathers, who made it the church of the convent. Returning to the parking lot in Piazza Roma you can try your luck again by playing the superenalotto in the Bar Biffi, famous for the billionaire super win of the year 2009.

Accessibility:

The Borgo di Bagnone has a flat path on an irregular surface with stone pavement at times disconnected in the main part from the parking lot with parking spaces reserved for wheelchair users in Piazza Roma up to Piazza Europa.

Subsequently, inside Via della Gora and Via Noceti there are slopes of more than 8% to reach Piazza Marconi. From there there is a descent with a gradient of more than 8% on a gravel surface to reach Via della Dogana.





Memory Archive Museum: Not accessible from the main entrance due to the presence of 2 steps, but accessible from the elevator and at the back in Via Nicolo' Quartieri.

Church of San Niccolò: Not accessible due to the presence of steps. Access could be allowed from the door on the right due to the presence of steps with an intermediate floor sufficient for the wheelchair to stall between one step and another.

In Via della Dogana, 6 the **Tourist Information Point** accessible via a ramp.
