Description



The town of Greve is located along the SR222 provincial road, in the heart of Tuscany, commonly known as **the Chiantigiana**.

It has characteristics of the middle hills and in its southernmost part those typical of a mountain environment. A center of significant strategic importance, during the last world war, it was the scene of violent clashes between the opposing sides, suffering devastating bombings that caused the almost total destruction of the town and infrastructures.

Greve in Chianti was born in the early medieval period and became the market of the Castle of Montefioralle in 1200. Its main square (Piazza Matteotti) still retains its triangle shape with arcades. From a historical and administrative point of view, before entering the province of Florence, it was part of the vicariate of San Giovanni Valdarno, an important administrative

and judicial district of the Republic of Florence established in the fifteenth century to govern and defend a vast strategic territory located between Florence and Arezzo.

In the surroundings of Greve in Chianti reachable by car there are:

The Castle of Verrazzano

Via Castello di Verrazzano, 1 Località Greti 50022 Greve in Chianti.

In the castle, owned by the Florentine Da Verrazzano family, the illustrious explorer and navigator Giovanni da Verrazzano was born in 1485, to whom the statue in Piazza Matteotti is dedicated. Today the Castle of Verrazzano is a magnificent structure that houses cellars, vineyards and tasting rooms.

In the car park there is a parking space reserved for people with disabilities near the Reception. Unfortunately, the guided tour of the cellars and the garden is not accessible to disabled people in wheelchairs due to the presence of several steps, but it is possible to access the restaurant for wine tasting.

Also near Greve it is possible to visit the **ring village of Montefioralle**.

The most convenient accessible parking is located in Piazza Santo Stefano. Here there are 2 parking spaces reserved for people with disabilities.



In the surrounding area it is also possible to visit the **Pieve di San Cresci**, a church of Romanesque architecture, a place of Catholic worship. One of the oldest churches in Chianti.

Small free parking adjacent to the Pieve, dirt road passable for people with reduced mobility. Unfortunately, it is currently closed for renovation.

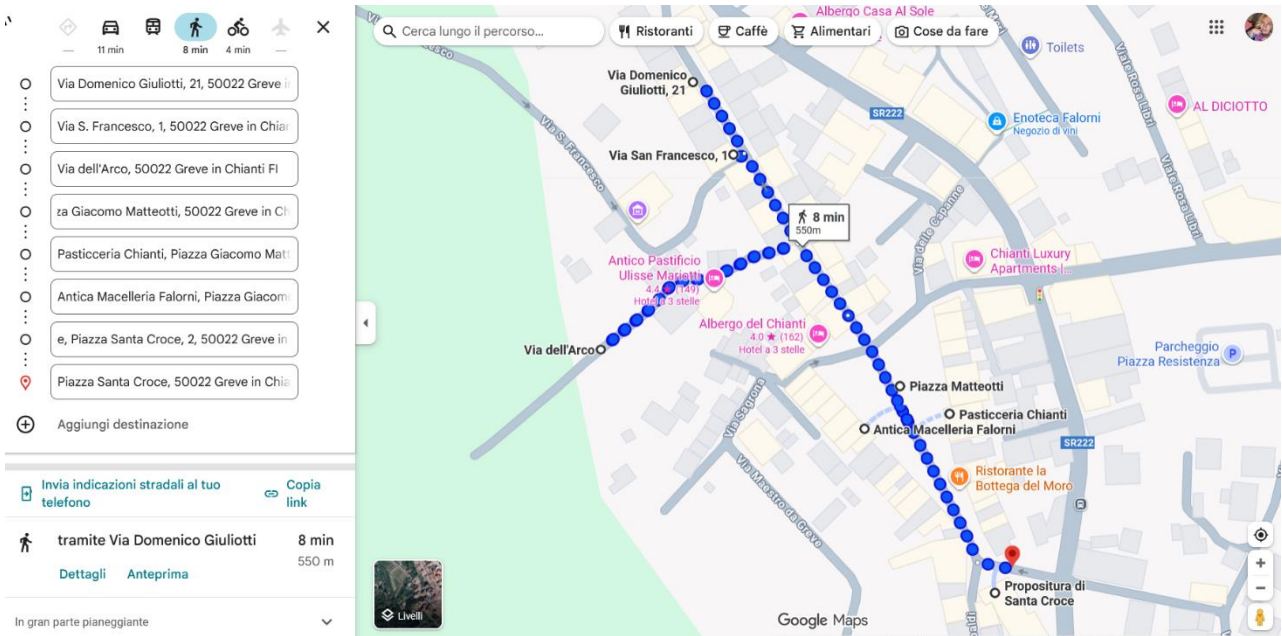
Pathway from the car park to the entrance

Pathway from the car park to the starting point	It is advisable to start from the parking lot with spaces reserved for people with disabilities in Via Domenico Giuliotti, 21 .
Distance from parking to entrance	Variable from 300 meters to 10 meters

Description of the itinerary



Length	About 550 meters

The very simple itinerary winds along a surface with stone paving, mainly smooth with irregular sections and some differences in height. The departure is scheduled from the parking lot in Via Domenico Giuliotti 21.

After a few meters you will find yourself at the crossroads that leads on the right to **the Museum of Sacred Art, Former convent of San Francesco**, and in the center on Via Roma, thus entering the heart of the historic center full of small characteristic shops, also accessible on the flat or with small steps.

After about 50 meters, on the right, we find Via dell'Arco with a very nice landscape view. Continuing on Via Roma, for another 50 meters, you arrive in the majestic **square dedicated to Giacomo Matteotti**. Characteristic funnel shape, it was called for centuries the "Mercatale a Greve", because for centuries it represented a market area. Even today the market is present on Saturday mornings. Its large porticoes outline its contours.

In the center, it houses the statue of **Giovanni da Verrazzano**, discoverer of the New York Bay.

On the top left is the building of the Municipality of Greve and on the top right the tourist information office. Walking along the entire square you reach the Piazzetta Santa Croce, to visit the **Propositura di Santa Croce**, with free admission, with a neoclassical façade, Inside the fresco of the Virgin Mary and Child and a triptych by Lorenzo di Bicci. On the left of the church there is a flat access to evade the front steps. The interior has three naves in Florentine Renaissance style.

Accessibility:

A visit to the Museum is not recommended because the climb to reach it is very steep and it is preferable to reach the entrance later by car.

Via Roma: the pavement is made of stone and the surface is quite smooth

Events

In Greve in Chianti, key annual events are the **Chianti Classico Expo** in September, the **Flower Festival** in early May, and the **Antica Fiera** on the first Wednesday of September. In addition, the weekly Saturday morning market is held regularly, with handicrafts and typical local products such as pecorino cheese and Chianti Classico wine. Known for its wine and medieval castle, today it is a lively village with shops, restaurants, wine bars and





artisan workshops. Greve in Chianti is also home to numerous cultural events, such as the weekly Saturday market and the "Empty the Attic" market.

Accessible public places

All the arcades of Piazza Matteotti can be accessed via connecting ramps. The flooring is in stone tiles. Here we find:

the ancient Falorni butcher's shop with indoor and outdoor tables and accessible toilets.

The Chianti Pastry Bar is accessible both externally and internally via a ramp at the entrance and has a bathroom accessible to the disabled.

The famous **restaurant Il Gallo Nero**, symbol of Chianti, is accessible on the flat in Via Cesare Battisti, 9. Inside, the toilets are accessible to disabled people in wheelchairs.

Adjacent to the parking lot in Piazza Resistenza, in Via Luca Cini, 4 there is the **restaurant pizzeria la Torre delle Civette**. How to feel at home on vacation, excellent pizzas and traditional dishes. Entrance accessible through a small step <5 cm and accessible toilets.

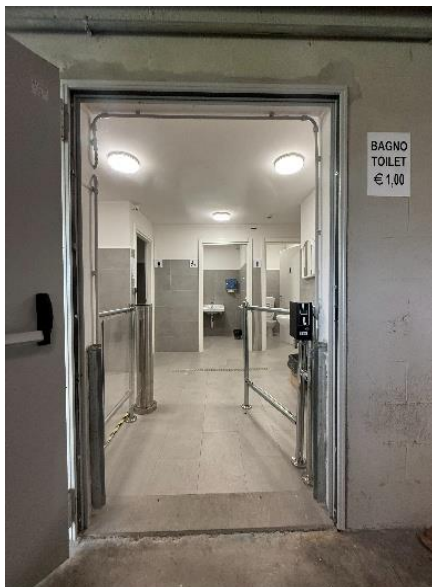
