## Description



Monteguidi is a frazione of the comune of Casole d'Elsa in the province of Siena, Italy. The territory is remembered in the will that Count Ildebrandino VIII Aldobrandeschi signed in Sovana on 22 October 1208, as a castle to be bequeathed to Ildebrandino il Rosso together with other possessions. In the thirteenth century the village passed from the jurisdiction of Volterra to that of Siena, in fact on April 17, 1300 Monteguidi appointed its own podestà who submitted to the Sienese Republic. Today the town still maintains its original structure, elongated in a north-south direction, for one hundred and thirty meters in length and forty in width. The two gates, located at the end of the major axis, have been preserved. Monteguidi is remembered by literature and cinema in fact in the famous novel *La ragazza di Bube*, by Carlo Cassola, set in Val d'Elsa, the protagonist,

Mara, lives in Monteguidi with her father, a militant communist, her mother and a brother. According to the story, it was in Monteguidi that he met Arturo Cappellini, known as Bube. A sympathy is immediately born between the two and Mara, flattered by the boy's interest, begins to exchange letters with him until she falls in love with him. The novel ends with a chapter in which Mara, seven years later, is described in the serene wait for the release of Bube, a partisan, for which she will have to wait another seven years before being able to embrace him again. The meaning of the literary work revolves around love and the constancy of the protagonist's feelings in the face of life's adversities. The painter Augusto Bastianini, born in the family home in Via Cavour, in 1875, is also linked to Monteguidi. During the years of artistic production, the artist focused on the study of nudes, portraits commissioned by the Sienese and Florentine upper middle class, and painting of the fields, linked to the rediscovery and love for the territory around Monteguidi. When he died in 1938, shortly before the outbreak of the Second World War, his wife Lina Batacchi closed the studio in Florence and his grandchildren brought all the works to the Monteguidi palace.

	To reach Monteguidi (Milan/Bologna/Florence), take the A1 motorway, exit at Firenze Impruneta, continue on the Firenze-Siena highway (Raccordo), exit at Colle Val d'Elsa Nord, and then follow the signs for Casole d'Elsa

The route inside the village is mainly flat with a small stretch that has slopes. The itinerary starts from Via dell'Amore. The first attraction of the itinerary is the **celebratory bust dedicated to the painter Augusto Bastianini**. The work was commissioned to the sculptor Morandi, who has his art studio right in the center of Casole d'Elsa. The work was born from the three-dimensional transposition of the painter's self-portrait, kept at the Uffizi Gallery and exhibited in Casole d'Elsa in 2013 and 2023. Morandi managed to "give life" to Augusto with a work that stands out for its naturalness. From here, continuing for about 9/10 meters, turn left until you find a ramp that directs you towards the **Church of the Visitation or former church of Sant'Andrea**. In this street you can see the stone houses with a typical medieval architecture. After a few meters we find the former church of Sant'Andrea in front. The church has a gabled and stone façade. It was probably the former church of Sant'Andrea, later reduced after various restorations, to an oratory for a centuries-old company. The church is currently closed. The north gate adjacent to the church is well preserved. It consists of an external stone arch and a deeper vaulted one, in brick from the inside with a round arch.

### Accessibility:

From the celebratory bust dedicated to the painter Augusto Bastianini, continuing for about 9/10 meters, turn left until you find a ramp about 18 meters long and a slope of 12% that directs you towards the Church of the Visitation or the former church of Sant'Andrea.

The first section of the pavement is asphalt and then continues in stone blocks.

From here continue towards Via Cavour on obstacle-free pavement. Via Cavour represents the central street of the village. Characterized by medieval structures, it has on the right side the **Palace where the painter Augusto Bastianini was born in 1875**. The building is now plastered with a commemorative plaque dedicated to the painter. The plaque was created and affixed to the wall in 2013 by the Municipality of Casole d'Elsa and commemorates the birth in this building of the artist, professor at the Academy of

Fine Arts in Florence, masterful portraitist and appreciated interpreter of the Tuscan landscape. The artist was born in Monteguidi in 1875, dying in Florence in 1938.

The itinerary continues in the direction of the **Church of Saints Andrea and Lorenzo** located on the right, right at the end of the street.

From here, turning right, the religious building appears. Very little remains of the original Romanesque building. A stone and brick arch framed by a terracotta decoration.

### **Accessibility:**

Via Cavour has a flat pavement made up of stone blocks without obstacles.

The Church of Saints Andrea and Lorenzo has a door with two leaves that can be opened inwards. It has an external step of 5 cm and an internal step of 7 cm.

The net door opening is more than 90 cm.

The central interior door has a net clearance of more than 90 cm and 2 side doors with a net clearance of less than 90 cm.

The interior of the church is very simple, it has a single nave that ends with a semicircular apse that has a crucifix hanging in the center. In the second half of the 60s of the last century the church saw an adaptation of the presbytery area. On that occasion, unfortunately, the seventeenth/eighteenth century stucco altar was demolished. With this intervention, the main altar facing the people, the seat, two ambos and two side altars in

the nave were built. All these elements were made of travertine. The church was consecrated on May 10, 1969.

Inside there are some valuable works from Siena, including the painter Casolani, a native of Casole d'Elsa. During 2013 the restoration work began which involved the entire building and a consolidation intervention with the use of micropiles that allowed the foundations of the church to be restored.

Leaving the church and turning right, the south door is located at the end of the major axis. Unfortunately, unlike the southern one, only a round stone arch remains of this gate.

### Accessibility:

he altar area has 2 steps, the first of 15 cm, the second of 20 cm.
