## Description

The church was built next to the fifteenth-century "monastery of the Olivetans", the current seat of the Archaeological Museum. The work on the church, subsequent to that of the monastery, began in 1340 and ended in 1375. The building suffered serious damage during the bombings of the Second World War in which the façade was the least damaged part. The interior, once rich in works of art that have been lost, has a single nave completely rebuilt after the Second World War.
