The first city walls date back to the twelfth century. The current walls date back to 1565 when the Medici decided to redevelop them. The work lasted 30 years and many prisoners were employed for the new construction. The hexagonal walls were equipped at the corners with imposing defensive bastions.

The first flat route up to the beginning of Via Alfieri. From here there are two ramps that connect to a single ramp (see description above)</p> <p>The second flat route up to Via Saffi. From here there is a ramp 28 m long, 200 cm wide slope 15.5%</p>
