Description

During the visit it will be possible to admire the Fonti dell'Abbondanza and the most important buildings of Piazza Garibaldi including the Cathedral of San Cerbone, the Palazzo Podestà, now home to the Archaeological Museum and the Palazzo Comunale. From the square you continue along the main street, until you reach the Porta di San Rocco.

The Fountains are located under a building consisting of three arches that precede pools, once containing water. The unique feature of the fountain is the fresco called "tree of fertility", a tree with phallic fruits with women in the foreground trying to grab the fruit.

The Cathedral of San Cerbone overlooks the square from the top of an imposing staircase. Built in the 11th century, it has undergone renovations and modifications. Inside, you can admire the Maestà by Duccio di Boninsegna and the marble ark of San Cerbone.

Palazzo Podestà was built around 1250 and over the centuries has not undergone major architectural changes even though over time it has served many functions. It currently houses the archaeological museum organized into two sections: the prehistoric and the Etruscan.

The town hall is composed of three blocks built in different periods. Over the centuries it has undergone renovations and modifications.

<p>Any notes</p>	<p>The cathedral is accessed via 16 steps that cannot be overcome with any precaution. There are two entrances, the main one and the side one, both with steps. Inside the nave are free of obstacles but the chapel where the Maestà by Duccio di Boninsegna is located has three + two steps. The altar also has three steps.</p>





	
	
<p>Any notes</p>	<p>The Palazzo Podestà, home of the archaeological museum, has 6 steps to access and 1 step at the main door. The Palazzo Comunale has 2 steps at the main entrance. The paving of the square is made of stone blocks but is free of obstacles.</p>





From Piazza Garibaldi, continue along Corso della Libertà on stone block pavement until you reach Porta di San Rocco, an integral part of the oldest circuit of the thirteenth-century walls preceding the formation of the New City.
