## Description

During the seventies of the twentieth century, the mining activity that marked the territory of the Metalliferous Hills for centuries began the decline that led, about twenty years later, to the definitive closure of the plants. A group of former miners and private citizens, gathered in COMASAM (Committee for the enhancement of the mining heritage of Massa Marittima) and in the Mineralogical Group, began to collect objects, work tools, cartography and disused machinery, proposing to the Municipality the creation of a museum to tell the story of the era that was closing. At a time when the mines were in crisis, but still in business, the Municipality with great foresight planned to set up two museums: the Mining Museum, which winds for about 700 m in some galleries set up like a real mine, and the Museum of Art and History of Mines dedicated to the exhibition of tools, cartography and minerals, many of which were donated by the same miners and citizens who had used or collected them. The two mining museums are now united under the name of SUBTERRANEO.
