## Description

The Guarnacci Etruscan Museum is one of the oldest and most important Etruscan museums in Italy. Founded in 1732, it preserves works of exceptional importance for the history of ancient Volterra. The large collection of Etruscan urns makes this museum unique in the world. More than 600 examples of these funerary containers dating back to between the fourth and first centuries B.C. decorated with mythological scenes and scenes of daily life. The museum preserves the famous statue Shadow of the Evening, (III century BC) the urn of the bride and groom, (I century BC) the stele of the warrior Avile Tite and the kourotraphos Maffei.
