Description

The Pinacoteca Civica di Volterra was established in 1905 thanks to the illustrious art historian Corrado Ricci. Since 1982 it has been located in Palazzo Minucci Solaini, one of the most important buildings in Volterra; attributed by local historiography to Antonio da Sangallo the Elder, it is the only palace in Volterra to preserve its Renaissance appearance almost intact. The Pinacoteca houses many valuable works among which the Deposition by Rosso Fiorentino stands out. Inside the building you can also admire the alabaster museum. The museum is divided into several rooms:

Floor 0 (underground) Alabaster Museum,

Ground floor Ticket office and bookshop,

Alabaster Museum Mezzanine,

Floor 1 Art Gallery,

Floor 2 Loggia
